Bryn Hafren Comprehensive School was an 11-19 girls' comprehensive school for approximately 1,300 students.

The main contractor for the project, the Bouygues Group would, as part of the Phase Two element of the development demolish the old school buildings, after the removal of asbestos. Following this, they created additional on-site parking areas plus landscaping and sporting facilities that included a four-court sports hall which is where the all-important choice of sports flooring would prove to be a crucial decision.
