Looselay

What is looselay flooring?

Looselay flooring refers to a type of flooring that is not permanently adhered to the substrate. Despite the absence of traditional adhesives, looselay floorcoverings maintain stability and durability compared to fully bonded floorcoverings, thanks to their innovative design.

This brochure aims to provide a comprehensive overview of the benefits of the different types of looselay flooring throughout its life-cycle, catering to end-users, specifiers, and installers alike.

Why choose looselay flooring?

Looselay flooring is engineered for quick and easy installation without the need for permanent adhesives. Gerflor design their looselay flooring with environmental considerations in mind, incorporating recycled and recyclable materials into most products.

The absence of permanent adhesives also reduces VOC emissions, enhancing indoor air guality for healthier environments. During installation, looselay flooring requires reduced sub-floor preparation and selected ranges are suitable for damp subfloors, resulting in significant time and cost savings.

The rapid installation process minimises downtime and disruption, allowing premises to remain operational. Looselay products are durable and many feature surface treatments that reduce the amount of water and detergent used during cleaning processes, reducing the operational carbon impact of products in use.

When no longer needed, looselay flooring can be easily uplifted without damage, facilitating reuse in future projects or recycling, thereby contributing to sustainability.

Our looselay flooring is engineered to provide outstanding stability, even during temperature fluctuations. This resilience ensures the flooring maintains its integrity and performance, regardless of environmental changes. We confidently provide a 10-15 year warranty for most of our products which provides you with long-term reliability and durability. This extended lifespan significantly reduces the need for frequent replacements which minimises waste and helps reduce the impact on resources. By choosing our products, you can ensure that your flooring retains its function and appearance for many years.

We offer Environmental Product Declaration's (EPD's) for our floorcoverings, and they offer transparent and standardised information about the carbon impact of our products. EPD's provide detailed insights into how our products contribute to the overall carbon footprint of an installation, enabling informed decision-making for environmentally conscious projects.

Our looselay products are fully compliant with REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals) legislation.

This compliance ensures that our products do not contain any toxic or harmful materials or chemicals, safeguarding both human health and the environment.

Looselay products provide a faster and easier installation process compared to fully-adhered flooring.

This efficiency is particularly beneficial in timecritical environments such as healthcare and retail, where minimising disruption is crucial. The quick installation process ensures that these spaces can remain operational with reduced downtime.

One of the standout features of looselay flooring is its ability to be installed over most existing hard floors. This makes it an excellent choice for refurbishment projects, as it simplifies the installation process and reduces the need for removing existing hard floors. Looselay flooring requires minimal sub-floor preparation, with some providing the ability to be installed over newly laid damp-subfloors **which makes it an ideal solution for new build projects**. This not only speeds up the installation process, but it also translates to lower material and labour costs.

Once installed, looselay flooring **can be walked on immediately. This means downtime is reduced and there is less impact on operations**. This is especially important in busy environments where prolonged closures are not feasible.

The absence of permanent adhesives in looselay flooring tiles simplifies the repair process. When damage occurs, individual sections of the flooring can be easily lifted and replaced without disturbing the sub-floor and surrounding area.



Without the constraints of permanent adhesives, these products can be **easily uplifted and potentially reused on new projects**. This capability **to re-purpose the flooring provides it with a second life**, extending its usability and helping the conservation of the Earth's resources.



Olympics Case Study

100% of the Taraflex Sustainable Looselay flooring installed and used during the Paris 2024 Olympics is currently being re-purposed in various sports halls and gymnasiums across France. This initiative involves 40 sports surfaces, covering a total area of 33,000 square meters.

The innovative looselay installation method has facilitated the reuse of these sports floors, providing many amateur athletes and schoolchildren the unique opportunity to play on Olympic-standard flooring. Among the facilities benefiting from this initiative is the CREPS in Strasbourg, which now features the same flooring used for the Paris 2024 Handball games. Additionally, a commune in Carpiquet has re-purposed the flooring from the Volleyball finals.




